# Challenge

- 500,000 square-foot installation area
- Four-story project
- 98% moisture readings
- Limited installation time frame
- Stringent construction budget
- Concrete slabs not flat enough to receive hospital floor covering

## **Situation**

The replacement Naval Hospital at Camp Pendleton was scheduled to open in six months. The facility provides advanced outpatient services with a patient and family centered inpatient design comprised of 60 inpatient beds, nine operating rooms with dedicated orthopedic, cystoscopy and cesarean operating rooms and six universal operating rooms. Newly poured hospital slabs were not level in many areas and RH tests revealed 98% moisture readings.
